In conjunction with the June 26, 2011 MassICES DOS we will be hosting a live, timed, anniversary cake challenge. Teams of three will work together to create a tiered anniversary cake in only 1 hour.

Trophies and ribbons will be awarded! Special Guest Judges!

The Rules

- Teams of three will be randomly selected from entrants during the meeting just prior to the beginning of the event. Who knows who you will be partnered with?
- Each team will have 15 minutes of planning time followed by 45 minutes of execution time to finish their entry and move it to the display table for judging.
 - Pre-made sheet cakes will be provided for each team. You may modify the cakes to suit your designs.
 - Buttercream and fondant will be provided for your use along with scrapers.
 - You will be provided with a “mystery goodie bag” of decorations and 2 pre-filled and colored icing bags of buttercream with attached tips. Plus a list of things that mark that year as an anniversary. You must use ALL the items in your bag to complete your design. These will include an appropriate anniversary cake topper.
 - Each entry must be at least 2 tiers in height. Additional tiers will earn you bonus points.
- Each team member should bring an apron, a cake spatula, and bread/carving knife. You may also bring a turntable.
 - Judges will be awarding 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards.

So have some fun during the stressful wedding cake season, and register to be a team member today!
